Take the next step on your Visible Mending journey or begin your journey with *Visible Mending Stories*. Students will create elaborate multi-layered specialty patches to apply to a fabric collage base to create a “story” or will use them to enhance and mend clothing. Specialty patches include: *Delightful Doily* patches (pictured above); *Fireworks* patches (pictured on the left); *Freeform Fantasy Island* patches that include needle lace and Shisha-style attachments; and needle woven *Holey Moley* patches. There is an optional \$45 kit plus shipping (see separate flyer for more information). See Supply list below.

Supply List

- Fabric Collage Base: 8” or 12” square: Fabric options: Wool blend felt, wool felt, wool fabric, cotton flannel, medium to heavy weight linen, craft felt. Your color choice. OR clothing you’d like to enhance with your patches.
- For Specialty Patches: Additional fabric bases in assorted sizes (see above list for fabric options). Make sure you have one that is large enough to back your doily or lace.
- Fabric scraps, tulle (enough to cover your Story piece and other patches as needed), painted cheesecloth (optional)
- Doily or lace (if you don’t have a doily) for *Delightful Doily* patch
- Yarn (for couching), ribbon or ribbon yarn (for ruching)
- Seed beads (Sizes 8 and/or 6), other bead types and sizes are optional
- Sea glass, tumbled ceramic or shell shard, or coin for Shisha attachment. (3/4”-1”)
- Threads: Pearl cotton (#8 and/or #12). Other threads your choice. Colors: your choice.
- Needles and pins: I suggest: Crewel Embroidery (#5, #3), Sharp (#6 and/or #5), Chenille (#22 and/or #20)
- Fabric scissors, embroidery scissors
- Removable marking pen/pencil
- Suggested: Clear plastic gridded ruler
